## Guidelines at *Camp Nicolet* Eagle River, Wisconsin

*Welcome to Camp Nicolet! To provide an enjoyable and rewarding stay with us, it is essential that safety and communication are our main considerations. We ask your cooperation in making this "quality time".*

**Smoking:** is prohibited in all camp buildings. When smoking outside, please extinguish all smoking materials in a safe manner and dispose of the butts in provided receptacles (not on the ground or in the lake, please!)

**Firearms, weapons, and explosives (including fireworks):** are not permitted on the camp premises. Gasoline or other flammable materials must be clearly marked and kept away from the cabin areas.

**Alcohol and illegal drugs:** The use of illegal drugs is prohibited on the camp premises. The use of alcohol is determined by the individual user groups and in accordance with Wisconsin State laws.

**Groundfires:** are not permitted for cooking purposes. A specific campfire area is available for your use in the Council Ring. No beach fires please!

**Vehicles:** the speed limit through the camp premises is a maximum of 15 MPH. Please keep all traffic to a minimum and use extreme caution because of small children, etc. A parking lot is available and secure to keep your vehicle. We ask that you do not park by your cabin, but keep your vehicle in the designated lot. All camp roads must be kept clear and passable for emergency purposes.

**Toilets:** our toilets are our friends - please treat them accordingly! Camp operates on its own septic system which can be sensitive. Do not flush anything other than toilet paper. **IMPORTANT:** Please do not drive vehicles over the septic area near your cabin.

**Cabins:** cabins are available to assigned participants (refer to registration information). Please turn off lights and close doors when leaving. Please do not write on the walls, bunks, etc. and leave your cabin as clean as you found it - thanks. Bathroom supplies, light bulbs, etc. can be obtained at the camp office. Wood is provided in your cabin woodbox. Please do not cut down branches or trees for your firewood or peel birch bark from live trees. The red metal fire bucket outside your cabin is for cleaning ashes from your fireplace – please do not deposit any flammable items in them or dispose of ashes in any other way!

**Showers:** the main camp shower house is for your use and showers may be taken at anytime. Please turn off the water, turn off the lights, and leave the door open when you are finished. Shower clogs, thongs, etc. are recommended - no glass containers, please!

**Personal Equipment/Possessions:** Camp Nicolet will not assume responsibility of any personal equipment or possessions (including animals) that you bring or loan to other campers. This includes theft, injury to yourself or others, and/or damage of these belongings. These items must be used responsibly following the camp guidelines.

**There are no pets belonging to guests allowed on the camp premises or in the cabins.**

**Recycling:** receptacles for recycling are placed around the camp grounds. Please use these when disposing of aluminum cans, plastic bottles, etc.

**Bikes, In-line Skates, Longboards, etc.:** **we ask that there is no bike riding or skating on the camp sidewalks or tennis courts.** Please have respect for older campers and small children – parents, please monitor this! We have miles of trails and camp roads and excellent pavement within minutes of camp - please ask!

**Swimming:** Camp Nicolet, Inc. will not be responsible for any swimming activity. If you wish to swim, you do so at your own risk and we highly recommend the following guidelines:

- a certified lifeguard (with CPR/1st Aid certification including training in bloodborne pathogens) be on duty during all swim and boating times.
- always maintain a 1:6 adult to child ratio
- never swim alone, always use the "buddy system"
- swim only in the designated swimming area
- no distance swimming outside of designated swimming area
- no running or horseplay around the water or on the docks
- no swimming after dark
- no skinny dipping (swimming nude)
- no lakebaths with soap or shampoo

**Boating Activities:** we ask that **lifejackets (PFDs) are worn** by all persons while participating in boating, canoeing, kayaking, sailboarding, or sailing activities. A craft checkout list is posted in the camp boathouse. Please follow posted safety regulations and “rules of the road”. No personal watercraft are allowed, i.e., jet skis.

**Recreational Facilities:** Forest Lodge, is available for recreational enjoyment. A ping pong table and wifi internet are available. Please assist us in keeping it neat and clean.

Tennis courts are available for your enjoyment but please wear tennis shoes only on the courts. No bikes, boards, or skates are allowed on the courts.

**Repairs/Maintenance:** if you should notice anything needing repair or should be brought to our attention, please report this to the camp office. Thanks.

### **Unauthorized Persons:**

If someone who is not a part of your group is present on site, please inform the camp office and/or the owners immediately. The person may be politely approached by at least two adults and directed to the camp office or the appropriate camp personnel. Camp Nicolet property boundaries encompass the stable area to the west and extend to Nicolet Village on the eastern shore. As we are surrounded by forest or water, parents/adults are to be responsible for their children and all family members at all times.

**Emergency:** phones are located in the camp office, and the owners' private homes. Emergency numbers are as follow:

**Ambulance** (Eagle River Memorial Hospital): 911

**Fire** (Hiles, Co. B): 911 or 479-3440 - our camp bell is rung 10 or more times to signal a fire or other emergency. User groups must notify camp personnel when emergency situations such as serious injury, lost or missing persons, fire, etc. occur. Although camp personnel are trained in CPR/1st Aid, user groups are advised to have a group member with these certifications on site. Groups are responsible for providing their own 1st aid care, supplies, and equipment and arrangements for emergency transportation. An AED is centrally located on the ground floor of the boathouse along with a first aid kit.
