Kitchen Staff - Camp Cook

[Seasonal, non-cabin Staff - minimum age 21+] [This position can be full- or part-time hourly. Can commute or live on-site.]

Camp Nicolet for Girls is a traditional overnight summer camp in Eagle River, Wisconsin. Family-owned and operated for over 80 years, our goal is to provide a safe, fun, educational summer experience for young women ages 7-17, and Staff ages 18+. Camp Nicolet seeks a **Camp Cook**, who along with Kitchen Assistants provides a quality, flavorful, and nutritious dining experience for the camp community. This position pays \$16.50 per hour; semi-private housing (if desired), all meals, and Workers Compensation Insurance are included as benefits. The contract length is from **June 2nd through August 19th, 2025.**

The Camp Cook has the following responsibilities:

- · Cook one or two meals a day, per shift schedule (breakfast & lunch, or lunch & dinner)
- Contribute ideas and suggestions to menu planning with Camp Director & Associate Director
- Obtain and maintain a current ServSafe food safety certification
- Maintain working knowledge of weekly menus, including dietary considerations (gluten, etc.)
- Use leftovers in an efficient fashion on the salad bar, in other recipes, etc. Minimize waste.
- Assist with the preparation of the kitchen and Dining Hall prior to the camp season
- Assist with ongoing inventory of Store Room, walk-ins cooler/freezer, and fridges
- Assist with serving area clean-up, and daily kitchen clean-up, including ovens, grills, & stove.
- Assist with Dining Hall clean-up as necessary (work with Kitchen Assistants) sweep & mop
- Maintain safe food handling environment following Wisconsin State Code & ACA Standards
- Ensure cleanliness of BBQ area and associated equipment (grills, tables, coolers, etc.)
- Maintain communication with Kitchen Assistants for any planning, needs, special events, etc.
- Assist with preparation and packing for Wednesday Cookouts (if aligns with work schedule)
- Assist with thorough end-of-season cleaning of kitchen & Dining Hall
- Participate in weekly meetings w/ Camp Director & Associate Director, for planning purposes
- Report department grievances to Associate Director
- · Conduct oneself in a professional manner, in accordance with youth-oriented environment
- Other tasks as assigned within reasonable scope of abilities and position.
- Work to build appropriate working relationships with other Staff Members, through occasional appearances at other camp activities and programs
